Turning Point

CAST: 1 male, 1 female

Man: Any age.

Woman: Any age.

RUN TIME: 3 minutes

PROPS – None required.

STORY

Every story has a turning point. Human history, itself one vast story, is no different. Our turning point came when the infinite Creator became like his finite creation, "from the Wall Streets to the Hollywood Boulevards." This two-person dramatic reading reminds us that God "intruded in our history, invaded our timeline and incarnated in our muck."

THEMES

Readers' Theatre. Dramatic Reading. John 1:1-14. Incarnation. Jesus Christ.

SCRIPTURE

John 1:1-14.

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Turning Point

MAN

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. All things were created through Him, and apart from Him not one thing was created that has been created."¹

WOMAN

God's story.

MAN

"Life was in Him, and that life was the light of men."¹

WOMAN

The climax of the story, the point of the plot.

MAN

"The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it."²

WOMAN

How did He tell the story so well? How did He weave the plot so carefully?

MAN

"He was in the world, and the world was created through Him, yet the world did not recognize Him. He came to His own, and His own people did not receive Him. But to all who did receive Him, He gave them the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name, who were born not of blood, or of the will of the flesh, or of the will of man, but of God."¹

WOMAN

His story intruding in our history, invading our timeline, incarnating in our muck.

MAN

"The Word became flesh, and took up residence among us."¹

WOMAN

Present in our trash.

MAN

"And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us." ²

WOMAN

Around our town. All the back streets and alleys, all the Wall Streets and the Hollywood Boulevards. He became us!

MAN

"So the Word became human, and made his home among us." ³

WOMAN

Became like you. Became like me.

MAN

"The Word became flesh and blood..." ⁴

WOMAN

"...and moved into the neighborhood. We saw the glory with our own eyes..." ⁴

MAN

We could see Him.

WOMAN

"And we saw His glory..." ²

MAN

We could touch Him.
